NRA Basic Pistol Shooting Course

Description: This course includes 3 classroom sessions and 1 range session learning to shoot revolvers and semi-automatic pistols. Students learn NRA's rules for safe gun handling; pistol parts and operation; ammunition; shooting fundamentals; range rules; shooting from the bench rest and two handed standing positions; cleaning the position. pistol. Students will receive the NRA Guide to the Basics of Pistol Shooting handbook, take an examination and receive a course completion certificate. Bring unloaded firearm to class room; firearm not required to participate in class, gun rental available. Successful completion of course (attendance of all sessions required) meets firearms safety training requirements of Montana concealed weapons permit law. Students can also qualify for a Utah Concealed Carry Permit for an additional \$25 and attending one additional class session.

Successful completion of course (attendance of all sessions required) meets firearms safety training requirements of Montana concealed weapons permit law. Class limited to 10 people, student must have a NRA Basic Pistol Course Certificate or NRA FIRST Steps Course Certificate). Bring unloaded firearm to class. Firearm not required to participate in class, gun rental available.
